## What's CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture restores direct contact between farmers and consumers. By purchasing from your local farmer, you reap the benefits of fresh, tasty and nutritious food while working to maintain a healthy environment, a vibrant community, and a strong and sustainable local economy for all to thrive in.

## Why CSA?

In America food travels an average of 1500 miles before it reaches the dinner plate. Vegetables are bred for 'shipping qualities' not flavor or nutritional value. The CSA movement arose in response to the damage caused by large scale conventional agriculture to farmers, farm communities, and the environment.

## Who We Are

Pierpont Farms is a 34 acre family farm located 15 minutes south of Columbia. Pierpont Farms was founded in 2004 with the multiple goals of promoting sustainable agriculture, local and seasonal eating, community involvement and to provide a more traditional way of sustaining our family.

## Member Benefits

Spending money in advance for produce can be difficult although membership is designed to be a bargain in the long run. A full share includes ample produce for a family of four or two adults who cook at home regularly and eat a lot of veggies. A partial share is slightly smaller and designed for one adult vegetarian, two adults who don't cook as regularly, or a single parent household.

## Organic Information

We are not certified organic at this time but we are considering it since we already follow organic practices on our farm. We prefer to work with nature to find a balance rather than a quick chemical fix.

## How Does It Work?

With a pre-season payment, you purchase a "share" of the season's harvest. For 25 weeks, beginning mid-May, you will receive 7-10 different vegetables per week in a seasonal progression. When you sign up you dedicate yourself to being our customer for the year and we, in turn, dedicate ourselves to being your farmers. It's a relationship that helps ensure the survival of small farms, local food supplies and agricultural land.

Each season there are likely to be some crops that do exceptionally well and others that produce less than expected. As partners in agriculture we share the benefits of bumper crops and the risks of a crop failure. We minimize our risks with irrigation, row cover and season extending structures that provide a buffer from Mother Nature's vagaries. Due to unpredictable weather patterns which we expect to get worse, we've invested in a 30'x96' high tunnel and a half-acre Haygrove Tunnel.
